

NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA CUSTOMERS

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data

Dear Customer,

Centro Diagnostico Omega srl, as the Data Controller, wishes to inform you that the personal data you provide will be processed in accordance with the principles established by Regulation (EU) 2016/679: lawfulness, fairness, and transparency.

1. Purposes of processing

1.a The personal data you provide will be used for the following purposes:

- fulfillment of contractual obligations (e.g., provision of the requested service, etc.);
- compliance with the requirements of competent authorities;
- compliance with the requirements of European laws, regulations, and provisions;
- protection of rights in court;

For the purposes indicated, the provision of data is mandatory, and any refusal to provide the data, in whole or in part, will make it impossible to perform the service you have requested.

1.b If you wish, and subject to your specific consent, medical and diagnostic reports may be downloaded online. Before giving your consent, you may review the dedicated privacy notice pursuant to

Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679.

We inform you that the choice to use this service is optional. You may, in fact, decide to pick up the paper report at our service counters as you have always done.

The information you provide to access your online medical report (tax ID number and access code, also known as a token) will be processed solely to enable you to access the service.

2. Legal basis for data processing

1.a *The legal basis for the processing of personal data pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2016/679 is the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or the implementation of pre-contractual measures taken at the data subject's request;*

1.b *The legal basis for processing personal data in connection with the online download of medical reports, pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) of the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2016/679, is the consent to the processing of personal data given by the data subject in relation to the specified purpose.*

3. Types of data processed

The data controller processes the following categories of data:

- general personal data as defined in Article 4(1) of EU Regulation 2016/679, namely: first name, last name, tax identification number, payment details;
- special categories of data as defined in Article 9 of EU Regulation 2016/679; 4. Methods of processing personal data

4. Methods of processing personal data

The treatment will be performed:

- dal solo personale autorizzato per lo svolgimento delle attività di trattamento;
- only by personnel authorized to perform data processing activities;
- using manual and electronic systems;
- by individuals authorized to perform such tasks in accordance with the law;
- by implementing appropriate organizational and technical measures to ensure data confidentiality and prevent access by unauthorized third parties.

5. Retention period for personal data

Your personal data, which is processed for the purposes indicated in point 1(a), will be retained for the time necessary to perform the service and in accordance with the data and document retention periods required by law.

The online report will be available for a limited time (up to 45 days) from the date it is generated, as indicated on the document provided to you at the time of registration.6. Disclosure of data to third parties

6. Disclosure of data to third parties

The information collected will be processed exclusively by personnel authorized by the data controller.

A. We would also like to inform you that, when disclosure is necessary or essential for the performance of our activities in relation to the stated purpose, personal data pertaining to medical and personal analyses may be disclosed to third-party entities (such as the Local Health Authority), which collaborate with us to carry out the requested service (including, for example, testing laboratories, medical specialists, etc.). The disclosure of such data is mandatory, and failure to provide it will make it impossible to carry out the requested task or service.

Pursuant to Article 12 of Decree-Law No. 179/2012, converted with amendments by Law No. 221/2012, as amended by Decree-Law No. 34/2020, furthermore, effective May 19, 2020, the Electronic Health Record (“EHR”) is activated and automatically populated by law with your digital health data and documents regarding clinical events, on an ongoing and timely basis, by the healthcare professionals and providers who treat you within the National Health Service facilities; the Omega Diagnostic Center is also included among these facilities.

7. Disclosure of personal data and transfer to countries outside the EU

Your personal data will not be disclosed.

Your data will not be transferred or disclosed in any way to third countries outside the European Union.

8. Automated processing

Please be advised that the personal data you provide will not be subject to automated decision-making in any way.

9. Rights of the data subject (Articles 15–22 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679)

Under current law, the data subject may, upon request, access their personal data at any time; if they believe the data to be inaccurate or incomplete, they may request its correction or supplementation, respectively; where the legal conditions are met, they may object to the processing of their data, request its erasure, or request the restriction of processing. In the latter case, with the exception of storage, personal data subject to processing restrictions may be processed only with the consent of the data subject, for the legal exercise of a right by the data subject, for the protection of the rights of a third party, or for reasons of substantial public interest.
